2. Competition Details: Well-Being of Students

Generally, students who have recovered from mild or asymptomatic COVID-19 infection can resume physical activities as tolerated. 2. Competition Details

Format of Play: Modified Stroke Play (Refer to Slide 12)
2 rounds of 9-holes

2. Competition Details

Holes:	Snr Boys & Jr Girls -> Hole 1 (for 2 days) Snr Girls & Jr Boys -> Hole 10 (for 2 days)
Tee Box :	Senior Boys: White Tee Markers and Junior Girls: Red Tee markers (Hole 1 – 9) Senior Girls and Junior Boys: from the same tee markers (Hole 10 – 18)

2. Competition Details

Team: Senior Boys & Girls

Events: A team of 2 players

Total aggregate scores of both players

Format of Play (Individual & Team Events)

- Play 2 rounds of 9-holes over 2 days
- Modified Stroke Play
- Individual: Winners shall be decided by the total gross score over 18 holes

Team Event: Aggregate gross scores of both players over 2 days

Modified Stroke Play

The Committee has adopted the <u>Maximum Score</u> as the form of Modified Stroke Play in this competition

- The Maximum Score for a hole is double par plus one stroke (7 for par 3; 9 for par 4 and 11 for par 5)
- A player who does not hole out under the rules for any reason gets the Maximum Score for the hole

- To help keep up with pace of play, players are to stop playing a hole when the score has reached maximum
- Maximum Score cannot be applied to players who do not complete the stipulated round

2. Competition Details: Technical Matters

- NO practice round will be arranged
- Walking Course (Trolley [not powered], carry own bag)
- Distance Measuring Device (DMD) allowed but without slope rating

2. Competition Details: Technical Matters

- No free relief from footprints in the bunkers
- Players must smoothen the sand in the bunkers after hitting

2. Competition Details : Scorecards

- Exchange Scorecards
- P Player; M Marker / Names
- Responsibility of players to check scores and delete Marker's scores.
- Sign on the "Players / Markers" space

2. Competition Details : Scorecards

- Write scores legibly
- Initial on any cancellation of score
- Players to verify flight mates' scores in form of verbal certification after every hole

2. Competition Details: Draw List and Local Rules

- Draw List: 29 April to 2 May for checking by schools
- Local Rules : Uploaded on NSG Website

2. Competition Details: Reporting & Starting Time

- > To register at least 30 minutes before tee off time
- Golfers should be <u>changed*</u> and ready for play when arrive
- Proceed to Golfers' Lounge for registration
- Collection of scorecards : TM to collect
- Report to Starters <u>at least</u> 10 minutes before stipulated tee off time to avoid any penalty

2. Competition Details : Attire

With reference to SPSSC Golf Rules and Regulations Point 21

"All golfers must be suitably attired in accordance with the requirement of the sport, i.e., collared tops and shorts (not school PE shorts) or long pants and skirts (for girls). Boy's shirt must be tucked in at all times. The attire must bear the school's crest / logo / name."

All prize winners must be in their tournament attire with their school's name / crest / logo or in their school attire (School uniform or T-shirt)

2. Competition Details: Pace of Play

- To keep up with pace of play
- SGA Group Pace of Play will be strictly enforced

2. Competition Details: Submission of Scorecards

- Golfers should finalize the score with their markers before they sign on scorecard
- Golfers must resolve any appeals / dispute of scores / penalties with TD before signing on the scorecard

2. Competition Details: Submission of Scorecards

- A golfer's scorecard is officially returned to the Committee when the player has physically stepped out and left the recording area
- Any protest will not be entertained once the submission the result is verified and signed by the TD
- Golfer's Lounge is out of bound to all Team Managers during the submission of scorecards

2. Competition Details : Decision of Ties

Please refer to Terms of Competitions Point 8

8) The decision of Ties (Applies to Awarding of Prizes and Achievement Pins)

In the event of a tie for any position, the winner will be determined by matching scorecards based on the best score based on the following sequence:

- a) Day 2 last 9 holes, last 6 holes, last 3 holes, 9th hole
- b) Day 1 last 9 holes, last 6 holes, last 3 holes, 9th hole
- c) Day 2 hole by hole, starting with last 9 holes of Day 2

2. Competition Details: Results

- The competition is officially closed when TD has signed off the overall result sheet.
- Prize presentation : Day 2
- > Final results will be posted in NIS

2. Competition Details : Suspension of Play

- Activation of evacuation plan from Laguna National
- In case of inclement weather, resulting in the inability to complete a round, the competition will be abandoned at the discretion of the Org Com

2. Competition Details : Arrival

- Drive to L1 Guest Car Park
- Players go unload golf bag and set up trolleys at the designated area located at L1 car park

2. Competition Details: Arrival

- All Team Managers who drive are to park at L1 Guest Carpark and enter via L1 entry point
- NO Complimentary parking

2. Competition Details: Putting Green

Seek cooperation from all Parents, Coaches & Team Managers to keep away from the putting green and Tee Box. (only golfers are allowed)

3. Personnel: Team Managers (TMs)

- All TMs must remain in the golf club throughout the competition and be easily reached in case of emergency
- > NO refreshment and meals will be provided for TMs
- > F&B outlets at the club are **NOT** halal certified.

4. Other Matters: Toilets / Water Points

- > Toilets: Located at Buggy Area, Half-way house
- Water-Coolers : Located at Buggy Area, Half-way house

4. Other Matters: Important Documents

Golfers must possess a valid golf insurance before they tee off

Please email renewed insurance to Org Sec asap (for expired insurance)

Laguna National : **<u>DO NOT</u>** sell Day Insurance

4. Other Matters: Important Documents

Incomplete registration (not attaching the required correct documents) will lead to disqualification
